## Grants – guidelines for organisations

One of the key objectives of the Eleanor Palmer Trust is to assist *“the relief of persons in the area of benefit who are in need, hardship or distress.”*

### To qualify for a grant

It is a requirement that beneficiaries live within the old (pre-1965) Urban Districts of Chipping Barnet and East Barnet (basically most of EN5 and EN4 and parts of N11 and N14 postal codes). We do not support requests for grants for educational purposes as there are other local charities for this need.

We support not-for-profit organisations which carry out charitable activities in accordance with the eligibility criteria above. Where an organisation operates both within and outside the area of benefit, if grants cannot be ring fenced for the area of benefit, then a proportionate grant may be considered.

### How to apply

Trustees will consider written applications from organisations which require assistance with the purchase of various items or with the funding of a particular service or project.

If requests come from external agencies on behalf of individuals, one of our application forms will need to be completed.

When applying for a grant as an organisation, you should provide details of:

1. Your organisation's circumstances
2. The purpose of the grant
3. A copy of your latest accounts.

Provision of this information enables Trustees to fully consider applications without requesting further information, thus speeding up the grant authorisation process.

Each grant application is considered on its own merits by the Trustees and a decision is made to support the application or not.
